

Frequently Asked Questions

How much does it cost to order a Redskins Maryland license plate?

Cost of the Redskins Maryland license plate is a one time fee of \$55, which includes the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) fee of \$25 and a \$30 tax deductible gift to the Washington Redskins Charitable Foundation (WRCF).

Can I make an additional tax-deductible donation the Washington Redskins Charitable Foundation when I pay for my Redskins license plate?

Yes, on the back of the application form you may indicate a one-time monetary contribution. Please add this amount to the \$55 license plate fee and submit your payment for the total amount.

Does the \$55 cover vehicle registration fees?

No, the license plate fee is not part of your vehicle registration renewal fee.

What are my payment options?

The Washington Redskins Charitable Foundation accepts Visa, MasterCard and American Express cards. If paying by credit card, please fill out the credit card authorization section located on the back of the application. If paying by check, please make checks payable to the Washington Redskins Charitable Foundation.

Cash payments will not be accepted.

Can I request that my Redskins license plate be personalized?

No, these organizational plates are not available with specific letters and numbers will be generated at random.

Can I request a specific plate number request, like "0089"?

No, we will not take special requests for plate numbers. The MVA will assign plate numbers at random and it is up to the discretion of the MVA as to what numbers will be generated. Please note that plate "0000" will not be issued as a valid Redskins license plate.

The Washington Redskins Charitable Foundation will be holding the first 100 plates to auction off at a later date during the 2009 season. Stay tuned to www.redskins.com for more information on our upcoming auction.

Can I get a Redskins license plate for my passenger car, multi-purpose vehicle or truck?

Yes, these license plates will be available for display on all of the above vehicles. Trucks will be allowed to display these plates up to and including one ton.

Can I get a Redskins license plate for my motorcycle?

No, Redskins license plates will not be available for display on motorcycles.

Can I get a Redskins license plate for my boat or trailer?

No, Redskins license plates will not be available for display on boats or trailers.

If I have a disability plate, can I order a Redskins disability license plate?

No, these specific plates will not be available. You may still purchase a license plate but must display a disability hangtag on your vehicle.

How long will it take to receive the Redskins license plate once application form is submitted?

The Washington Redskins Charitable Foundation will process applications and payments in batches. Applications will be submitted to the MVA on a bimonthly basis for processing. Once the MVA receives the submitted application, plates will be issued from the Glen Burnie office, which processes plates on a daily basis. Plates are typically received in approximately four to six weeks.

Where will the license plates be mailed to?

License plates will be mailed directly to the address filled out on the application.

What do I do with the original license plate issued by the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration?

Once the new license plate has been received, please return the original plate back to the MVA. You can return original plates in person to any MVA branch office or mail them to:
